Born in 1999 and registered in 2000, Asian School of Cyber Laws (ASCL) is a global pioneer in cyber law and cyber crime investigation. ASCL is a registered society and public charitable trust. We are headquartered in Pune, India's education capital.

We have assisted the Government of India in framing draft rules and regulations under the Information Technology Act.

ASCL Computer Crime & Abuse Report (India) is the only study of its kind quoted by the United Nations in its E-commerce & Development Report (2003).

We have conducted training programs on Cyber Crime Investigation, Incident Response and Cyber Forensics for senior Government and Police officials and corporate sponsored professionals from Malaysia, Japan, South Korea, China, Singapore, Malaysia, Hong Kong, Mauritius, Nepal, UAE, Philippines, USA, UK, Thailand and Ghana.

We have conducted training programs for various national level Government bodies including National Academy of Direct Taxes, National Police Academy, National Institute of Bank Management, National Insurance Academy, Vaikunth Mehta National Institute of Cooperative Management and Securities & Exchange Board of India (SEBI).

We have assisted the Indian Army, various branches of the Indian police and the Central Bureau of Investigation in matters relating to cyber investigation.

We have built the Collaborative Online Investigation Network (COIN) - an interactive platform empowering the world's enforcement agencies to tackle cyber crime & other cases involving digital evidence. COIN was launched by Shri Devendra Fadnavis, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Maharashtra on 27th July, 2015 at the c4 Conference on Cyber Crime Control, 2015 at Mumbai.

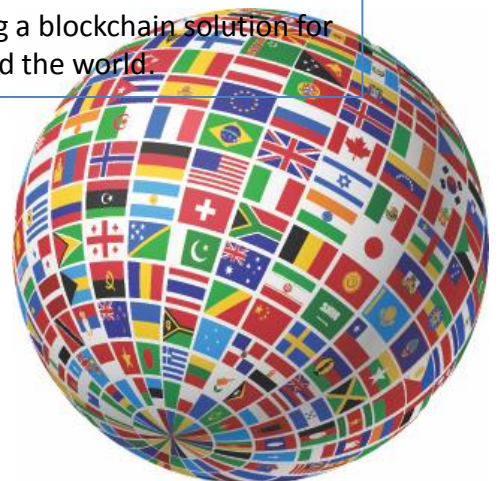
